Dear Parents of Brookes Saint Petersburg,

**RE: Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update**

Further to my letter, dated Monday 16th March 2020, I am writing with Brookes Saint Petersburg's latest position regarding the Coronavirus.

1. Until further notice, the school remains open to all students; no indication of mandatory school closure has yet been given by the Saint Petersburg authorities.
2. Parents may still continue to make the decision as to whether their child/ren come to school or not. Optional attendance - please indicate to your child's form tutor if you are coming to school or not.
3. All staff will be onsite providing both onsite and distance learning for all students.

The above arrangements are governed by the following weekly dates and school calendar. We will not be clear on what arrangements may extend past these next three weeks until some point in the future, but will contact and communicate that to parents as we become clear. Equally there may be an interim decision that affects us keeping the school open - we will keep you informed.
